

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-06-01
SECTION 14 METROPOLITAN DISTRICT
REGARDING ESTABLISHMENT OF A SECURITY SERVICES
PROGRAM

A. The District was organized in 1987 as a metropolitan district to provide those services a metropolitan district is authorized to provide, including but not limited to, security services as set forth in C.R.S. Section 32-1-1004(7).

B. It has been brought to the District's attention that the needs of its constituents and taxpayers include the need for security services in the public areas within the District's boundaries ("**Security Services**").

C. The District has funds available in its general fund to provide Security Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of Section 14 Metropolitan District, Jefferson County and City and County of Denver, Colorado:

1. The Recitals set forth above are incorporated herein by this reference.
2. The District hereby establishes a program for Security Services to be provided to the public spaces within the District's boundaries as general depicted on the map attached here to as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by this reference. (the "**Security Services Program**").
3. The District hereby directs the District staff to:
 - (a) Distribute notice ("**Notice of Intent to Intiate Security Services Program**") to the Jefferson County Sheriff's Department, the Denver County Sheriff's Department and the City of Denver Police Department (the "**Law Enforcement Agencies**") of the District's intent to proceed with the Security Services Program and to include within such notice the following:
 - (i) The intended start date of the District's Security Services Program.
 - (ii) A form of the Unarmed Security Contract for the provision of Security Services to be entered into by the District that contains the terms for executing the Security Services Program.


(b) To initiate the Security Services Program fifteen (15) business days after the delivery of the Notice of Intent to Initiate Security Services to the Law Enforcement Agencies.

4. Judicial invalidation of any of the provisions of the Resolution or of any paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or word herein, or the application thereof in any given circumstances shall not affect the validity of the remainder of the Resolution, unless such invalidation acts to destroy the intent or essence of this Resolution.

5. This Resolution may be amended from time to time by subsequent Resolution of the Board of Directors of the District.


