

## SECTION 14 METROPOLITAN DISTRICT

The Section 14 Metropolitan District is a Title 32 Special District that has been established for the purpose of financing and installing street, park and recreation, water, sanitation, mosquito control, and safety protection of the District; and all other improvements or services permitted by Article 1, Title 32, C.R.S. (collectively, the “Public Improvements and Services”), except as specifically limited by the Service Plan for the District approved by the Board of County Commissioners of Jefferson County, Colorado on November 11, 1986, as amended on November 7, 1989, as it may be further amended from time to time (the “Service Plan”).

The Public Improvements and Services are for the use and benefit of the residents and taxpayers of the District. The District is located in Jefferson County and Denver County, Colorado. The District is a quasi-municipal political subdivision of the State of Colorado authorized to provide specialized services that the Counties do not provide.

The District may incur a maximum debt of \$16,000,000. Ad valorem property taxes and other legally available revenues may be used to repay such debt.

The District may assess a maximum mill levy of 30 mills to repay such debt. Such mill levy may be adjusted in the event of reassessments or revaluations in accordance with State law.

The District must file an Annual Report with the Division of Local Government, the State Auditor, the Jefferson County Clerk and Recorder, and the City and County of Denver Clerk and Recorder.

The District boundaries located in Jefferson County overlap with the boundaries of: R1 School Bond Redemption Fund, R1 School General Fund, General Funds, Department of Social Services, Development Disability Fund, Library Fund, Road & Bridge Fund, City of Lakewood, Law Enforcement Authority, Foothills Park & Rec District Sub A, Urban Drainage & Flood Control District (South Plat), Urban Drainage & Flood Control District, West Metro Fire Protection District – General, West Metro Fire Protection District - Sub D, South Metro Fire Rescue Fire Protection District, and Grant Water and Sanitation District.

The District boundaries located in the City and County of Denver overlap with the boundaries of: City and County of Denver, Denver School District No. 1, and Grant Water and Sanitation District.
